- 2 liter of Soda

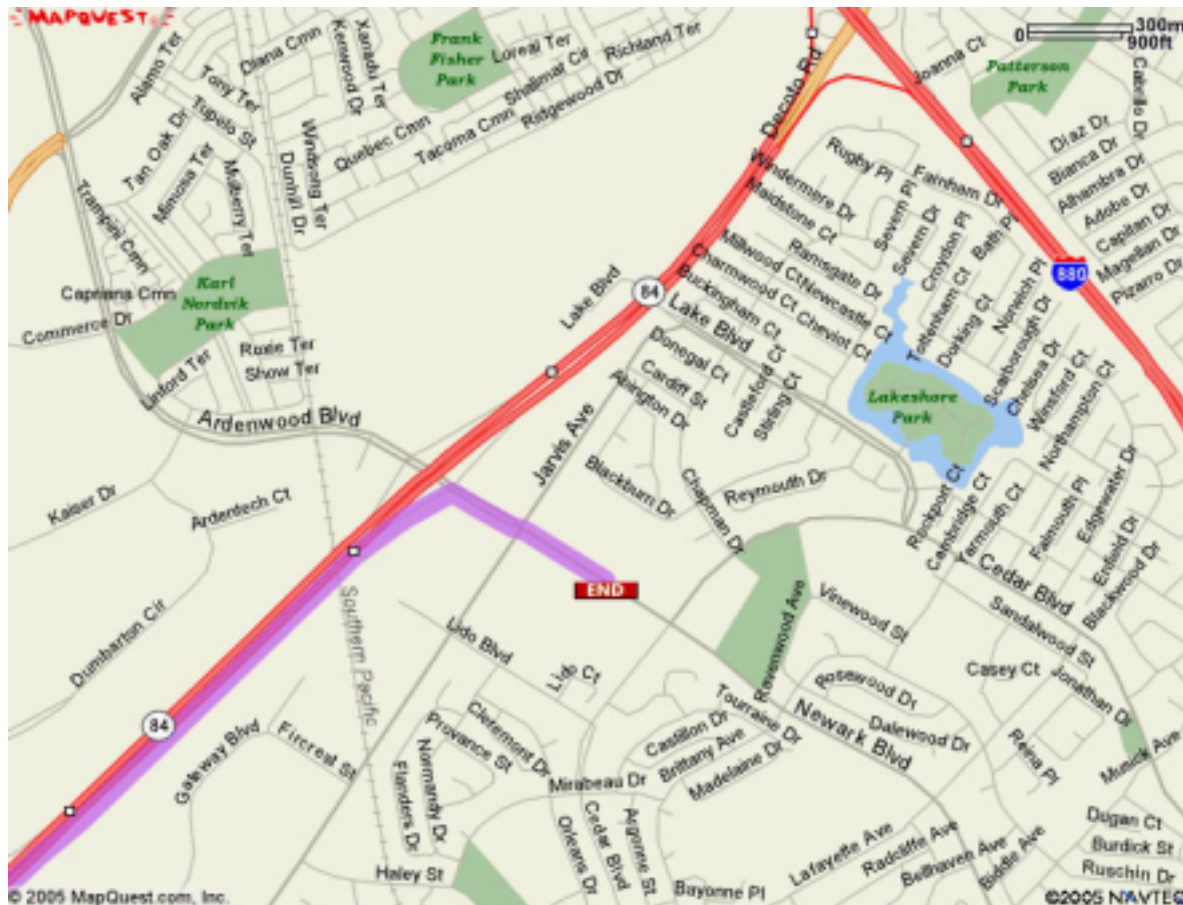
Total price is \$28 and that includes tip and taxes. I think they are giving us a real good price.

It receives AM/FM broadcast, SW broadcast, two way radio FM (30KHz), narrowband FM (12.5 KHz). It transmits VHF and UHF conventional and the new narrow band format.
